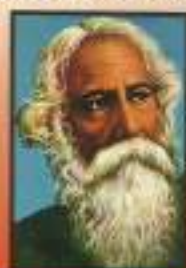

Art Education and Music are compulsory subjects for Classes I to VIII. The Work Experience subjects include Drawing, Music, Computers and Photography. Students are awarded grades instead of marks in these subjects.

School Security System :-

SPORTS AND ACTIVITIES

Prime importance is given to physical fitness and sports activities in order to bring about a co-ordination between body and mind.

- The school provides opportunity for various games such as Cricket, Football, Hockey, Basketball, Volley-Ball, Table-Tennis, Badminton, Athletics, Yoga and Aerobics, under the guidance of trained physical education teachers & coaches.
- Training is provided in Japanese Martial Arts like Tae-Kwondo and Karate.





SCHEME OF EDUCATION

English being the international language for communication and indispensable for rapid scientific and technological development of the country, the group of schools is bent upon a wide range of English literacy and therefore, adopts English as the medium of instruction.

Stage of Study :-

The age of the child should be 5 years at the time of admission for first.

Primary Level (Std. I to V)

During the primary level of education children have to use more of their brain and get an environment to communicate in English.

Middle Level (Std. VI to VIII)

Besides reading, writing, pronunciation and vocabulary, in in-depth care is taken to make the children learn behaviour, manners, etiquette discipline.





SCHOOL HOURS

Summer Timings

- School timings: 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- Recess timing: 10:00 a.m. to 10:20 a.m. The students are expected to report at the school premises by 7:25 a.m. in summers.

Winter Timings

- School timings: 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- Recess timing: 11:00 a.m. to 11:20 a.m.
- The students are expected to report at the school premises by 7:55 a.m. in winters.
- One-hour compulsory games for classes Vth onwards in winter after school hours for three days in a week.

Note :

- Students must be regular and punctual to school.
- Last Saturdays of every month shall be observed as Holidays for students.





IDENTITY CARD

Students are issued identity cards as per instructions of the local governing authorities.

- These identity cards are for the security of the students and hence should be maintained by the student for the full session.
- Students are expected to carry their I-Card every day to school. No student shall be allowed to enter the school premises without the I-Card, once it has been issued.
- In case the I-Card is lost by the student, it shall be mandatory to get a new I-Card issued on extra charge.

MORNING ASSEMBLY

The morning assembly helps each child to show case his or her talent and ensure a robust start to the day. It is the most serene feature of the school curriculum where students learn the value of collective prayer and are exposed to the need to inculcate moral and ethical values. They are guided to the path of spiritualism through educational talks. Meditation and introspection form an integral feature of the morning assembly.

Note : Students must reach the school premises before the commencement of the morning assembly. The parents should accompany their wards and clarify the reason in person, if the student is delayed due to an unforeseen contingency.





UNIFORM

Uniform constitutes an important part of the school's philosophy and the standardization of the dress code abolishes class distinction identifying each child only as a student.

For Summer:

Off White Shirt, Deep Brown Tunic or Pant, Tie, Belt, Black Shoes, White Socks,, White Ribbon or White Patkas (For Sikh students.)

For Winter :

Deep Brown Blazer & Pullover with school monogram, Off White Shirt, Deep Brown Tunic or Pant, Tie, Belt, Black Shoes, White Socks,, White Ribbon or White Patkas (For Sikh students.)

Note:

- *Students from class I onwards should wear White dress on every Saturday, sports day and on festive occasions. (On Sports day & House Dress)*
- *Students must have a clean handkerchief. Shoes must be polished every day.*
- *Wearing of Bindi, ornaments, fancy clips & mehndi is prohibited. Nails must be short and clean. Use of nail - enamel is prohibited.*
- *Only simple & small earrings may be worn. Students and parents will be responsible for any loss.*
- *Watches, if worn, are the responsibility of the student.*



ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

Admission to school is open to all who fulfill the entry requirements, followed by entrance test.

Admission to class Nursery is allotted on the basis of interaction and interviews of the child and interaction with the parents. Written test is held in the following subjects viz. English, Hindi, Math for class I to Std. V. Class VI onwards will have paper in science in addition to English, Hindi & Math.

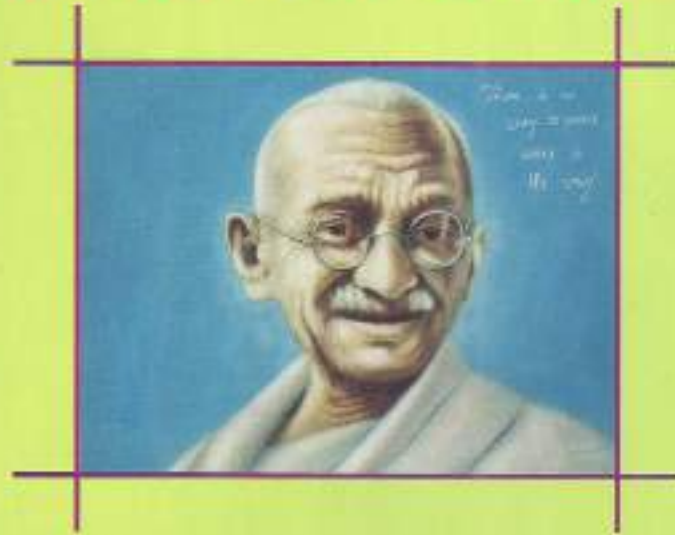
Parents / Guardians will have to submit Birth Certificate, Transfer Certificate, and report card of previous exam of the child at the time of admission.

Admission Fee, Tuition fee and all other fees for the first month should be paid at the time of admission.

One month's notice in writing is to be given before withdrawal of a student. A fee of Rs.200 is to be paid for T.C., No T.C. will be issued until all arrears of that term are paid.



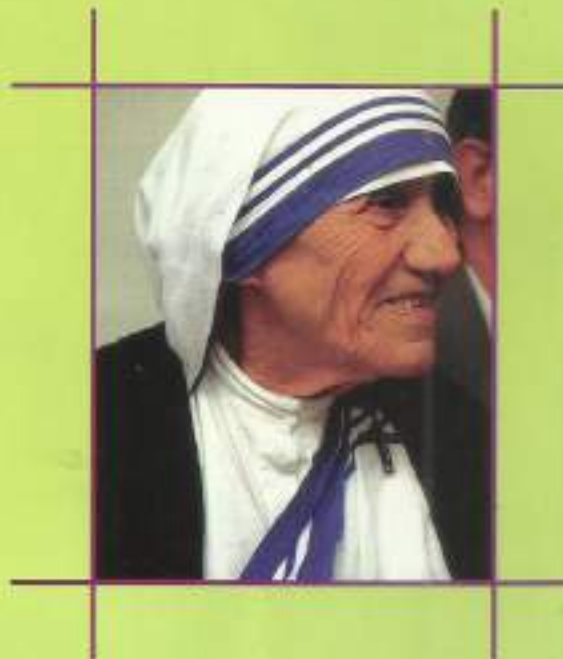

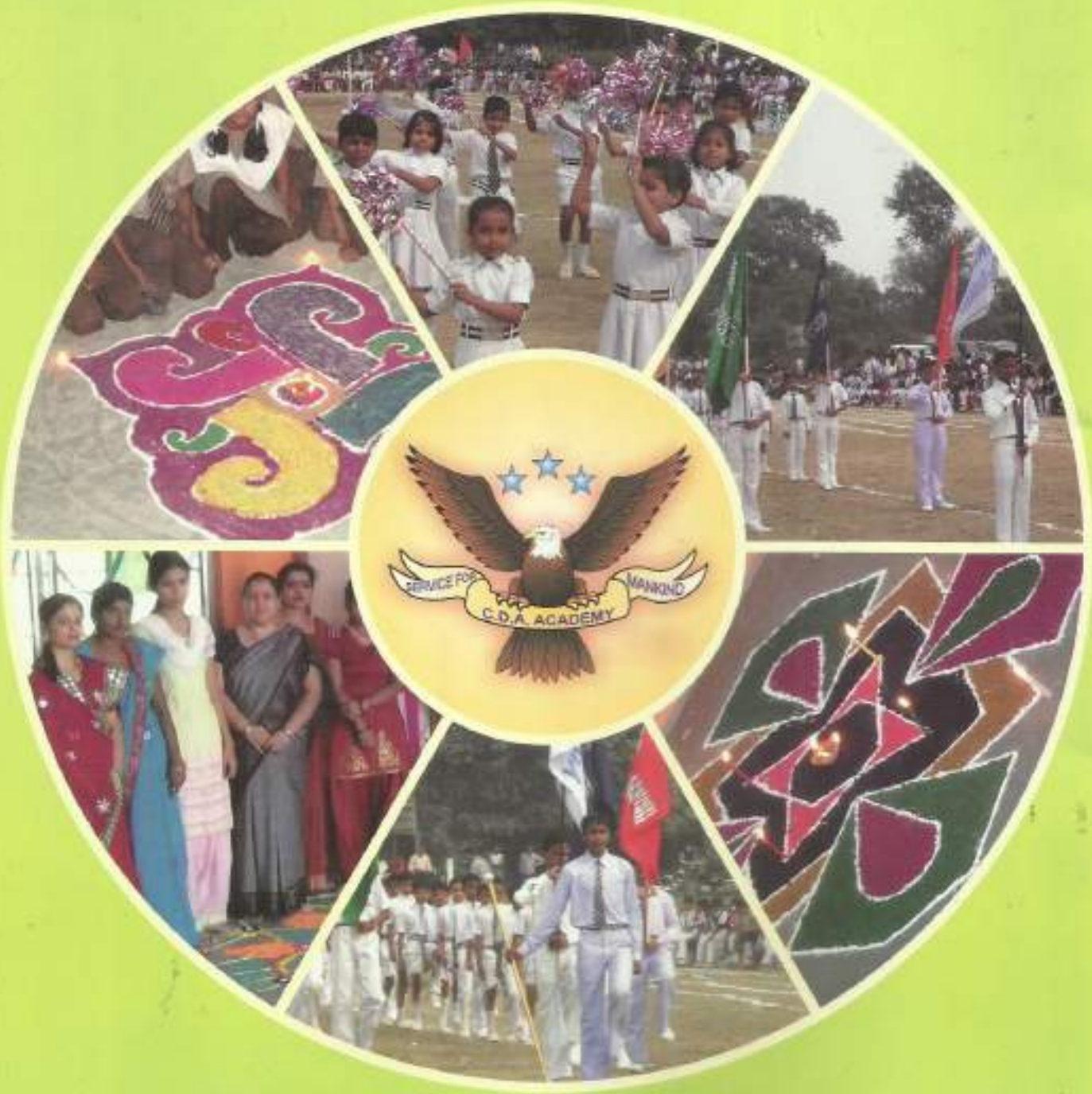
